

Ferrers Triangle Committee Meeting Minutes

Street Party Minutes Wednesday 2nd September 2009

1. PA - Richard has checked and we have booked the Cavendish Lodge PA (not the Streatham Festival PA). Richard is organising pickup and return.

2. Tea & Coffee stand - keen to have it in someone's front yard so that hot water urn is out of the way. Sally will ask Andy and Sarah about possibly using their front yard. Byron suggested John who lives in Ellora Road might like to help on the stand and promote his International Café at the same time. John has said yes to this.

Also, yes to providing soft drinks for kids. Will buy cartons from Lidl and small bottles of water. Have a bottle of squash as back up when cartons run out. To purchase 40 x small apple cartons, 40 x small orange cartons, 40 x small water. Sally has spoken to Logan, the shop owner of Oli Convenience, about him sponsoring the stall and providing milk, tea bags, etc. There are some supplies left over from the Pancake breakfast last year. Jane G has up to 48 mugs now available for the stand.

3. Finalised list of stalls and their requirements was worked out and will be emailed as a separate document.

Gazebos - Harriet to do a final check with Kirsty regarding using the Woodmansterne PTA gazebos. Harriet organising pick up of gazebos from school.

Byron and Cristina have said yes to us borrowing the film club blankets for the St John's House gazebo. People from St John's House, residential care home, have been invited to come along. We will set up a gazebo with chairs and have some one on hand to get cups of tea and cake for them.

Jane G purchasing face paints. We will put together our own kit of paints for use at the Street Party and any other events we do that require facepainting.

4. Chalk map of the world and graffiti art - Jane G will set this up in the morning of the street party by drawing the map of the world and some graffiti to get people started. Large tubs of chalk have been purchased and will be left out for people to use. The idea with the map of the world is that people can mark on the map where they are from, with tea lights or similar? Could be good to think of something that will work during daylight hours.

5. Sunflower Competition prizes and final round up - Jane G and Sally will do a final round up on Saturday afternoon at 1pm to take photographs of flowers and measuring. Prizes suggested so far are sunflower umbrella, sunflower gardening kneeler, sunflower bag and children's gardening set.

6. John advertising International Café, see item 2.

7. Street Olympics - will have egg and spoon race, three legged race, toddler grand prix. Plan to have separate adult and children heats. Jane G will organise scarves for the three legged race. Need 40 eggs for egg and spoon, half of them to be hard boiled. Jane G has medals to give out to at end.

8. Plant Stall - Sally to email Anna re FUF being involved and providing information at the stall advertising what they do. Jane G and Wendy have plants available for the stall.

9. Who is doing what on the day and the volunteer list - we have had a fantastic response from people in the neighbourhood keen to help on the day. A list of who is doing what will be emailed out separately and very soon.

10. Flyering next weekend - decided to do it this Saturday 5th Sept at 2.30pm. Meet at the cnr of Ferrers and Hambro Roads. Sally to email people who said they were keen to help. Will flyer Ferrers Road with the first notice regarding Ferrers Road being closed for the Street Party.

11. Road Closure signs for Ferrers Road - Jane W has one in her loft, think Duncan has the other in the basement of the pub. Sally to ask Duncan. Byron proposed that we keep the street closed for a bit longer outside the pub, people thought this a great idea.

12. Ferrers Triangle Stall and what will be on it - ideas so far include: a big Thankyou sign for people who provided sponsorship and raffle prizes, web address information, how to be added to the Grapevine list, info about past charities supported, FT events past and upcoming, invitation to join the committee (need a new name for this), survey, sunflower competition photos, info about Freshview and what they are planning for the community.

13. Percentage of money for charity - it was decided to wait until the dust settles and we know how much money there is and work out a percentage/amount then.

14. Big Nosh - decided to use the £10 voucher Sainsburys have given us to buy extra food for the Big Nosh. Will buy bread and supplies to make pizza (Sally), potato salad (Jane G), coleslaw (Sally), rice salad (Jane W). This is over and above what we would be bringing anyway. We ran out of food last year so keen to

have extra food this year. Jane W had a list of extra items needed for the Big Nosh and Cake Stall - wet cloths, sharp knives, cake servers, serving spoons, black bin bags (need to buy), table cloths (Jane G), saucer size plates for cakes (need to buy 100), napkins (have some, need to buy 200), plates (have some, need to buy 100), knives (have some), forks (have some, need to buy 50). Sally to organise purchasing what is needed.

15. Byron has organised with Mangit and Joanna (own property opp pub) for him and Cristina to project images on their wall and for the Street Party banner to be attached to the side of their property.

16. Liz to contact Chris, Ferrers Road bike man, to firm up his stand.

17. Street Party banner to be finished at Stitch n Bitch next Tuesday, 8th Sept. All welcome, 8pm onwards at the Earl Ferrers Pub.
