1. Newsletter

It was decided to leave the next newsletter until after the street party, late Sept early Oct. When we can give it some time and thought, give an update on the party and charities, money raised/ donated etc, and also use it to promote the Halloween party.

2. Website

Byron has taken over the construction and management of the website from Richard. He will be sorting out the confusion over the mailing lists by the beginning of next week.

3. Ellora Road Planters

Harriet has talked to Andrew about doing some running repairs on them. He agreed to do this and came up with a plan that will hopefully give them a couple more years life. He will be getting back to us over the cost. Andrew also suggested we re-stain the wood afterwards as any repairs will be in a different colour wood, it would also help to protect the existing wood from the effects of the weather. A short list of 4 charities was drawn up; Trust a charity that is based in Streatham who work with female sex workers, The Streatham Youth and community Trust, Spires homeless day centre, and South Thames cross roads a charity with offices based in Streatham offering respite care for people with disabilities.

Jane, Harriet and Cristina are going to get some more info together about all of these and this will be sent out to every one by the end of next week. People to vote on which charity to choose, and results to be presented to the next meeting.
